Once GIA receives your electronic FAFSA results and your GIA Financial Aid form, you will be sent via email an Estimated Eligibility Letter explaining your aid eligibility or a follow up secured email requesting additional information.

After first payment, and submission of the required admissions documents are received, admissions will confirm enrollment. We will contact you via email approximately two-to-three weeks before your start date, by email with a confirmation of your financial aid, and ask you to complete the Federal Entrance Counseling and in person entrance counseling.

**Important Note:** Students are required to pay the first payment at the time of enrollment if there anticiapted aid and estimated funding does not cover the full tuition.
